Rapunzel Alone follows the story of Lettie, a young mixed-race girl from London, sent to the English countryside for her own safety during World War II. On an isolated country farm, she faces her own battles with a strict new guardian and a very "fowl" goose. Created during the pandemic to address the feelings of isolation students have experienced, *Rapunzel Alone* is by Olivier Award-winning British playwright Mike Kenny.

- 1. *Enter Stage Right*: 1 in-person workshop, 1 field trip to 24th STreet Theatre, 2 buses. Best for grades 2-6. Cost: \$3900 for up to 100 students. Available beginning Spring 2023.
- 2. Theatre Residency: 45 minute in-person drama classes taught during the school day. Customizable to your school's needs. K-12. Available year-round. Cost: Starting at \$7200 for 4-5 classrooms for 6 weeks (variable based on budget/needs).
- **3.** After School Theatre: 60 minute in-person drama classes taught after school in a multipurpose room at your site. Customizable to your school's needs (weekly, bi-weekly, short term or full year). Available for early elementary, late elementary, or middle school. Cost: \$250/day for 20 students.
- Professional Development for Teachers: Topic options: Unconscious Bias + the Arts, Promising Learners, SEL Through Theatre, Teaching as a Performing Art. Available year-round. Cost: In-person \$3040 for up to 60 teachers/faculty/staff.
